Request for use of Veteran's Park: Phil Hoyt requested the use of Veteran's Park on September 13th,2020. He is having a benefit concert to raise money for Adopt A Soldier. Trustee Munger moved to approve the request and was seconded by Trustee Hyatt. The motion was carried unanimously with the condition that it may need to be rescheduled based on NYS Covid-19 Guidelines.

<u>Public Open:</u> Due to Covid-19 the meeting was closed to the public. There were no written requests from the public by mail or email.

<u>Executive Session:</u> Mayor Labas requested to go into Executive Session to discuss a personnel matter. Deputy Mayor Smith moved to enter Executive Session.
