

DO YOU NEED HELP PAYING FOR CHILD CARE?

As of August 1st, 2022, the income eligibility guidelines for child care assistance have increased significantly in New York State.

NOW more families can qualify!

OLD

Prior to August 1st, 2022: The income eligibility amount for a family of 4.

\$51,500.00

= 200% of federal poverty level

NEW

As of August 1st, 2022: The income eligibility amount for a family of 4.

\$83,250.00

= 300% of federal poverty level

If you have previously applied and were not approved, you could qualify today!


